## Barton Day Camps

All Day Camps are Coed

### Week 1:

**The Rainbow Club** – Greenwich, CT

All of The Barton Center camps must comply with regulations of the MA Dept. of Public Health and be licensed by the local board of health.



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## Resident Camp Programs

### Clara Barton Camp

*Girls, Ages 6-16*  
North Oxford, MA

Clara Barton Camp provides girls and young women with an exciting summer of making new friends, learning about diabetes, sleeping in log cabins and living Barton's non-stop fun. Campers get to experience swimming, sports, outdoor education, arts and crafts, music and drama, the challenge course, trips and much more! Whether it is because of the lifelong friendships they make, feeling part of the Clara Barton Camp Family, or just plain fun, campers call CBC their "home away from home."

Note that this year, Clara Barton Camp is offering "WACKY" sessions during the first week of camp! Campers can bring a sibling or a friend who does not have diabetes with them to camp during these sessions. The friend or sibling

will also pay a camp fee, and no financial assistance is available for children without diabetes. The friend or sibling should fill out a camper application with applicable medical information leaving the diabetes sections blank.

### Camp Joslin

*Boys, Ages 6-16*  
Charlton, MA

Camp Joslin provides boys and young men with an exciting combination of camping, fun, diabetes education, support and recreation! Campers get to experience a wide variety of camp activities such as archery, tennis, canoeing, sailing, swimming, sports of all types, and even a radio station, along with other boys with diabetes. Campers have described their time at Camp Joslin as the most fun they've ever had while also learning how to live more effectively with diabetes.

*Coed, Ages 13-17 or 15-18 (depending on program)*

### Adventure Programs

(Coed, ages 13-17)

- **Adventure Program 1** (operated with Holyoke Rows): A combination of rappelling, climbing, caving, snorkeling and kayaking
- **Adventure Program 2** (operated with Courageous Sailing): A Boston-based adventure. Learn to sail in Boston Harbor while experiencing the excitement of the city. Campers will stay in dorms at the Mass College of Pharmacy.

### Wilderness Leadership Programs

(Coed, ages 15-18)
